### *ESREA: The 6<sup>th</sup> European Research Conference*

Adult Learning in Europe – understanding diverse meanings and contexts

23-26 September 2010, Linköping University, Sweden

Adult education or lifelong learning or adult learning? Debates about choice of words announce differences in what we conceive of as our research field. Not only do the concepts vary, but also the contexts which we think are proper study objects: it can be learning at work, civic education, formal adult education, higher education or folkbildning (popular/liberal adult education) or informal learning among adults. Behind these labels are practices, which have been shaped into local versions. We need to explore this diversity in order to better understand each other's research. By making differences understood we might be clearer about what we have in common. A concrete manifestation of the theme will be to give some space for conversation comparing the concepts and contexts in the papers presented in each session.

### **Abstracts**

You are invited to submit an abstract addressing the conference theme. We welcome abstracts from all fields of research on adult learning. Contributions from colleagues all around the world are welcome. Abstracts should be no more than 500 words. **The deadline for submission of abstracts is January 15, 2010.**

The Scientific Committee of ESREA 2010 is responsible for the selection of the submitted abstracts. **Latest notification of acceptance is March 1, 2010.**

Please submit abstracts in two separate files: one including the paper title, the name, address, e-mail of each author; and the second one including the paper title and abstract. Please send your abstract in RTF-format.

## **Papers**

Completed papers should be submitted by August 16, 2010 and sent to: [karin.simu@liu.se](mailto:karin.simu@liu.se)  
Please send your paper in RTF-format. The paper should be 5000 - 7000 words.

## **Information for contributors of Abstracts/Papers**

- A paper is proposed and submitted in the form of an abstract by one person. Up to three other people can be named as co-authors in the abstract proposal.
- For each participant, a maximum of two such proposals may be submitted in which the person is named as an author or co-author.
- The abstract proposal must indicate which of the named authors will be presenting the paper. All those authors attending must register for the ESREA 2010 Conference.
- The author or one of the named co-authors is responsible for communicating with the ESREA Conference Organizers about the paper.
- The conference organizers will allocate a chairperson and a discussant for each paper.
- Accepted abstracts will be downloadable in PDF-format on the Conference website [www.liu.se/esrea2010](http://www.liu.se/esrea2010) Full conference papers will be downloadable on the website exclusively by the conference participants with a login.

## **Criteria for Review of Abstracts**

Abstracts for papers are welcome from all fields of research on adult learning. The criteria used in reviewing each abstract will be as follows:

- Should be directly related to specified aspects of adult learning;
- Should make reference to a theoretical framework, involve systematic enquiry of an analytic or empirical nature;
- Background, method, results and implications should be set out clearly in a manner which is accessible to an international audience.

## **Language**

The abstract, the paper and its presentation should be in English. Simultaneous translation will not be available in plenary sessions. However, in line with the ESREA language policy, efforts will be made to provide some translation in the parallel sessions.

Please bear in mind when presenting a paper that you are speaking to an international audience, the majority of whom may not be familiar with your own country let alone its adult

educational system. Please avoid the use of acronyms and do not use expressions which relate to your adult educational system without providing a contextualization.

## **Publication**

Submitted papers will be put on a CD which will be distributed with the conference pack distributed when arriving at the conference venue.

The conference organizers will review and select a number of papers for inclusion in an edited collection.

## **ESREA 2010 PhD student award**

One of the papers written by a PhD student will be awarded with the ESREA PhD student prize consisting of 250 Euros. The selection will be made by the scientific committee of the conference and cannot be overruled.

## ***Pre Conference for PhD-students September 22***

Developing Graduate Research Capabilities

22 September 2010, Linköping University, Sweden

A pre-conference for graduate-students, focused on the theme “Developing Graduate Research Capabilities” will be organized on September 22 starting at 9 in the morning. The pre-conference is based on workshops lead by leading professors from different parts of the world within the area of adult learning. The aim is to create a space for graduate-students to problematize and discuss important issues related to the practice of doing a PhD/EdD. Subthemes will be:

- Supervision
- The art of writing

- How to publish

Participants will be asked to read some articles and prepare questions in relation to the theme prior to the conference.

As this is a workshop based pre-conference, there will be no room for paper presentations. However, we would like to encourage graduate-students to submit abstracts to the main conference no later than January 15, 2010 as outlined previously in this call for papers.

The pre-conference is free of charge.

### ***Bursaries and support to participating graduate- students***

As a way to support graduate-student's participation in the conference, there will be 16 bursaries available in the form of free accommodation during the entire conference (from September 21 to September 26). To be able to apply, one needs to be a graduate student (e.g. PhD-student, EdD-student, master student); a member of ESREA (either individual or covered by an institutional membership) and one need to submit a paper to the main conference.

The bursary will cover accommodation costs at a youth hostel at the university campus and transportation costs from the hostel to the conference venue each day. Each room has four beds (thus you will share a room with three other participants). There will be separate rooms for females and males.

The hostel is located at a walking distance to the pre-conference venue, and there are good bus connections to the main conference venue (15 minutes bus ride).

Applications should be submitted no later than June 1, 2010. However, a first-come first-served procedure will apply.
